Revision

The outcome of the review (including any recommendations for revisions or improvements) communicated to authors by **30th September 2019**

Final papers

Final papers to be received by **15th October 2019**

The Dialogue Society and **the Journal of Dialogue Studies** invite papers from scholars and practitioners, who wish to explore ideas and share their research findings in the field of **dialogue** and **conflict resolution**.

Contributors are invited to critically engage with existing theories and methods utilised to peacefully end conflicts at various levels. In applying a theory to a case, contributors are invited to consider questions such as the following:

- How can success and failure be evaluated?
- What has succeeded and what has not yet succeeded in a selected case or cases?
- Can the theory or method be adapted or supplemented accordingly to deal with difficult cases?
- Or may it be necessary to combine the theory with other theories and construct tailored 'hybrid' frames for these conflicts at various levels?

OUTCOME

The event will be extensively publicised with a 'workshop proceedings book' published in advance of the workshop, with a special issue of *Journal of Dialogue Studies* and an edited book may follow.
